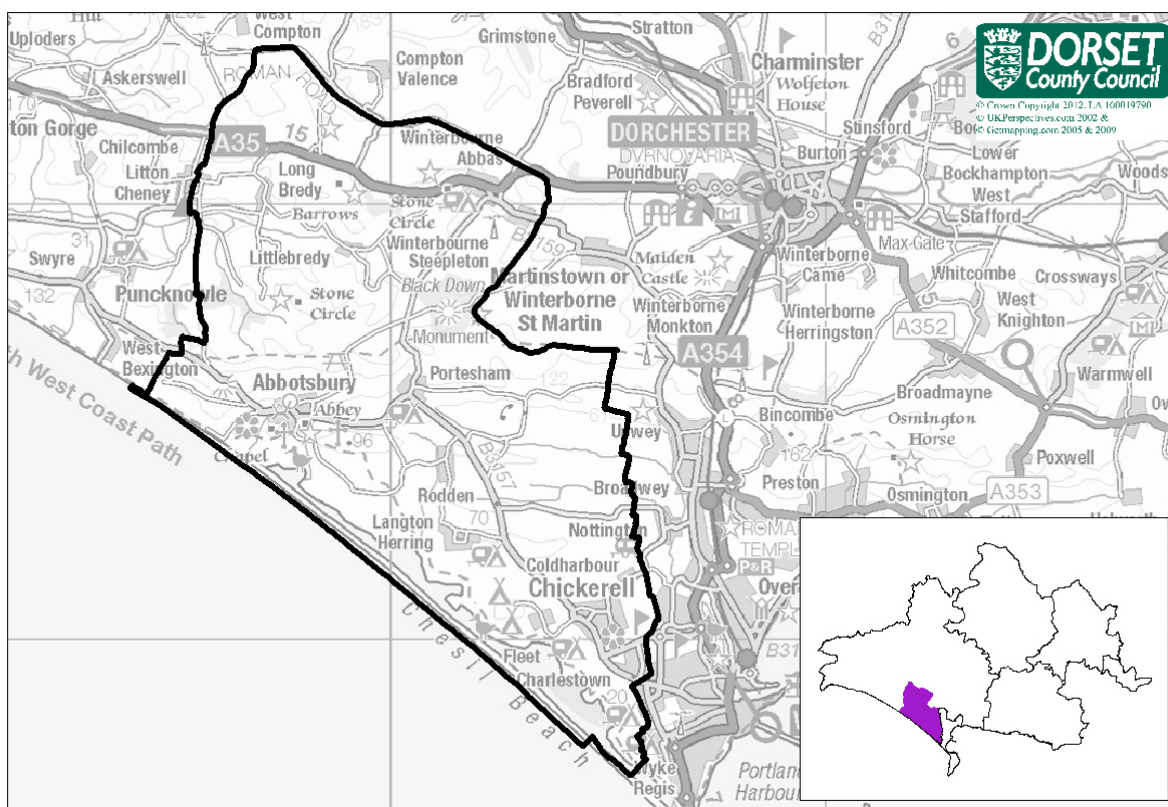


# Electoral Division Profile 2013



## Chickerell & Chesil Bank Electoral Division

Total Population: **7,900** (2011 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: **6,500** (Dec 2012, WDDC)

- Chickerell & Chesil Bank Electoral Division is composed of the following parishes: Chickerell, Fleet, Langton Herring, Portesham, Abbotsbury, Littlebredy, Kingston Russell, Long Bredy, Winterborne Abbas and Winterborne Steepleton.
- Within the division there is 1 community library and 4 schools (3 primary and 1 secondary)

- The majority of households are owner occupiers (73.2%). The proportion in private rented property is slightly above the County average (15.7% compared to 14.9%).
- There is a higher level of car ownership in this division, just 13.8% of households do not have a car.

- The majority of those economically active (52.3%) are employed full-time. Unemployment is slightly lower than average, 3.6% compared with 4% across Dorset.
- Of those economically inactive (16-74 years) most are retired (69.4%).
- Over 22% of those aged 16+ have no qualifications, whilst 24.4% have a higher level qualification (degree or above), lower than the County average (27%).
- Almost 37% are employed in a high skill occupation, lower than the County average (40%), whilst 18.3% have low skill occupations, above average for Dorset (16.6%).
