
Electoral Division Profile 2013



Linden Lea Electoral Division

Total Population: 9,550 (2011 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: 7,973 (Dec 2012, WDDC)

- Linden Lea Electoral Division is composed of the following parishes: Cheselbourne, Dewlish, Puddletown, Burleston, Tolpuddle, Athelhampton, Tincleton, Woodsford, Crossways, Owermoigne, Warmwell, Poxwell, Osmington, West Stafford, West Knighton, Broadmayne, Whitcombe, Bincombe, Winterborne Came, Winterborne Herringston, Winterborne Monkton and Winterborne St Martin.
- Within the division there is 1 library (Crossways) and 1 community library (Puddletown). There are also 5 schools (4 primary and 1 middle).

- The majority of households in the division are owner occupiers (74.8%).
- Car ownership in the division is high, just 9% of households do not have a car, whilst over 51% of households have 2 or more cars. This is typical in the more rural parts of the County where residents are most reliant on private transport.
- The largest part of households comprise married couples (with/without dependents) almost 41% are in this category, compared with a County average of 35%.

- Overall the health of those in Linden Lea division is slightly better than the County average.
- 18.7% of the division's population has a long term illness or disability, compared with 20.1% across Dorset. Over 82% describe their general health as good/very good, the County figure is 80.5%.
- Linden Lea has a higher than average proportion who are providing unpaid care, (12.8%)

- The majority of those who are economically active are employed full-time (51.6%). Linden Lea has a high proportion who are self-employed, over 20% compared with 18.4% across Dorset.
- The majority of those who are economically inactive are retired (69%). Just 7.2% are permanently sick/disabled, lower than the County average (9.7%).
- 32% of those aged 16+ have a higher level qualification (degree or above), this is higher than the County average of 27%.
- Over 44% of those in employment have a high skill occupation, again this figure is higher than the County average (40%). 14.7% have a low skill occupation, below average for Dorset (16.6%).
