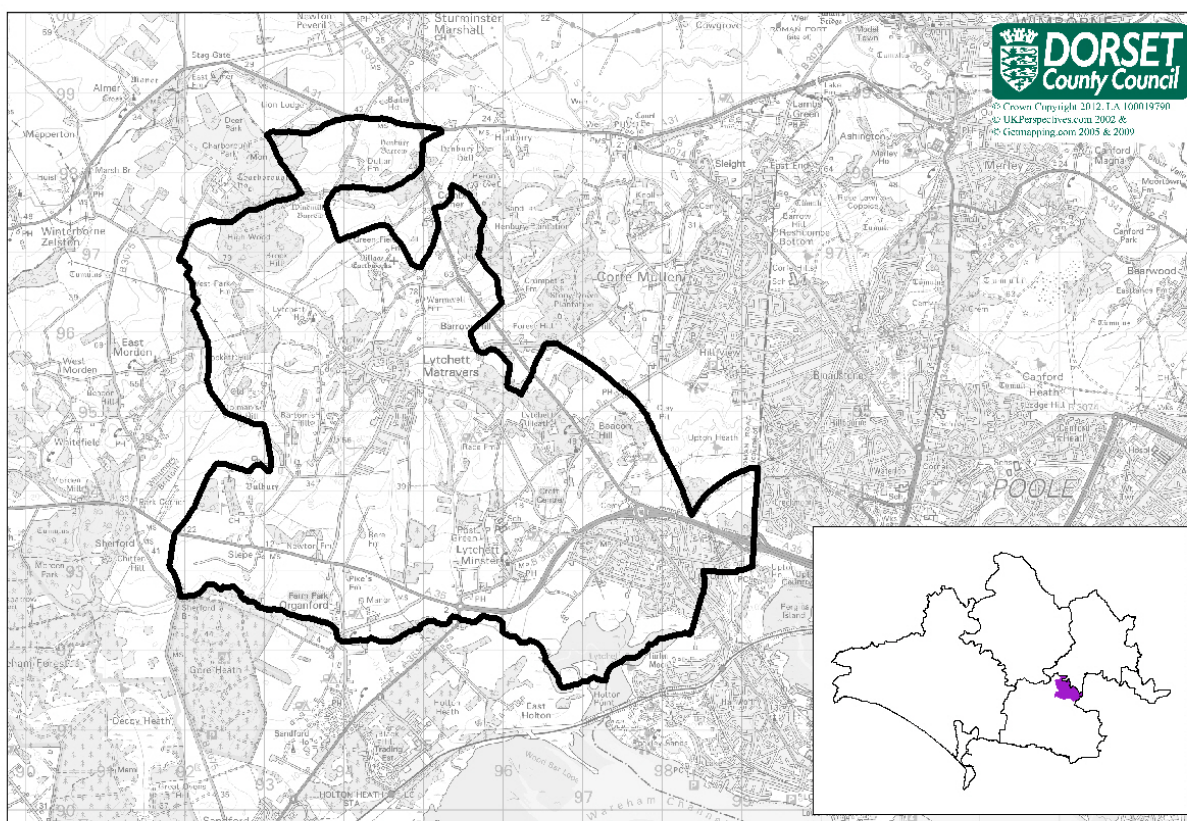


Electoral Division Profile 2013



Lytchett Electoral Division

Total Population: **11,410** (2011 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: **8,999** (March 2013, PDC)

- Lytchett Electoral Division is composed of Lytchett Matravers parish and Lytchett Minster and Upton parish.
- Within the division there are 2 libraries (Upton and Lytchett Matravers) and 4 schools (3 primary and 1 secondary).

- Lytchett division has a total population of 11,410 making it one of the larger divisions in the County.
- The age profile is younger than average, over 18% are aged 0-15 years. The County average is lower at 16.3%
- 20.8% are aged 65+ years compared with 25.2% across Dorset.

- Lytchett division has a relatively low proportion of both vacant properties and second/holiday homes. Overall 97% of dwelling have permanent residents.
- Almost 79% of households are owner occupiers, the County average is lower at 73%.
- Car ownership is high, just 11.3% of households do not have a car, whilst over 47% have at least 2 cars.

- Overall the health of those who live in Lytchett division is better than the County average, partly a reflection of the younger age profile.
- 17.3% of the population have a long term illness, lower than average (20.1%). Over 82% described their health as good/ very good, higher than average (80.5%).

- Of the economically active population over 54% are employed full-time, a further 24.5% are employed part-time. Just 14% are self-employed, the County average is 18.4%.
- The majority of the economically inactive population (aged 16-74) are retired (63.8%).
- Just over 23% of those aged 16+ in the division have higher level qualifications (degree or above), much lower than the County average of 27%.
- Less than 37% of those in employment have a high skill occupation compared with a County average of 40%.
