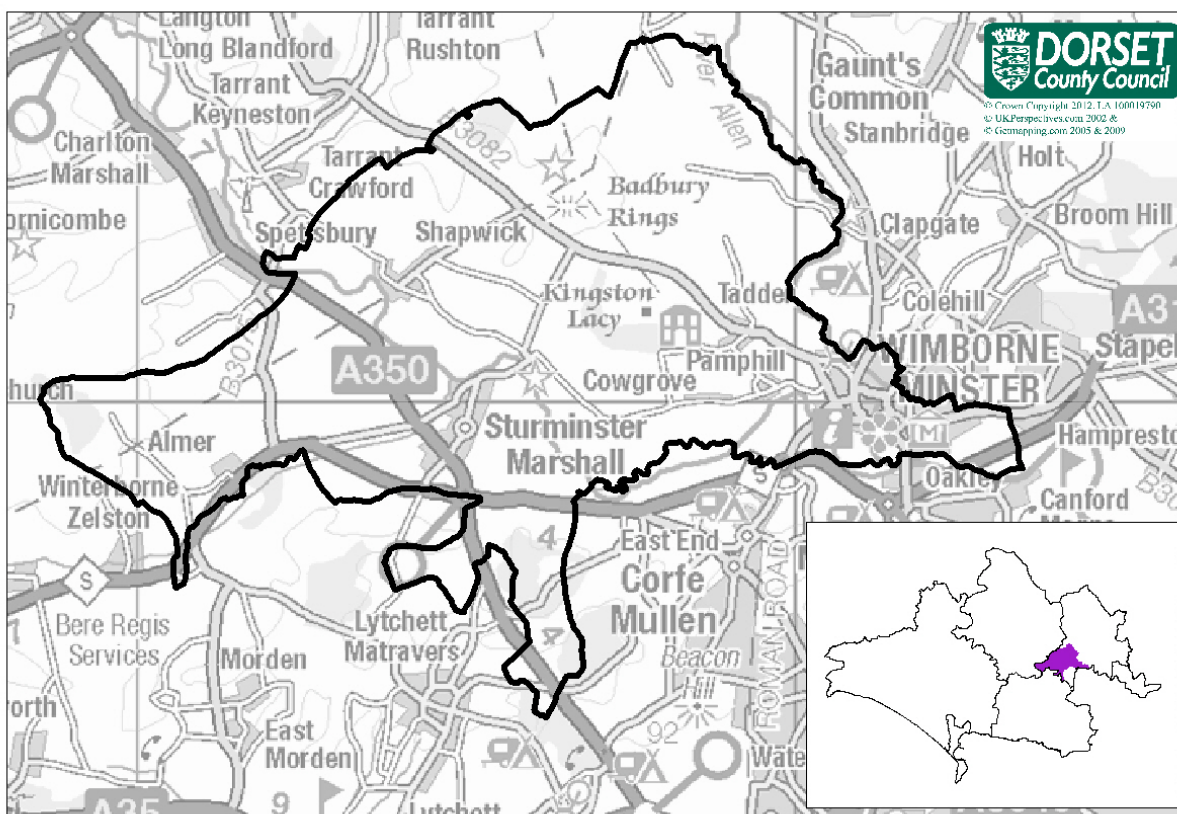


Electoral Division Profile 2013



Minster Electoral Division

Total Population: **9,600** (2011 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: **7,886** (Dec 2012, EDDC)

- Minster Electoral Division is composed of the following parishes: Sturminster Marshall, Shapwick, Pamphill and Wimborne Minster.
- Within the division there is 1 library (Wimborne). There are also 6 schools (4 primary, 1 middle and 1 secondary).

- Minster division has a total population of 9,600.
- The age profile in the division is slightly older than the County average, almost 25.6% are aged 65+ years compared with 25.2% in Dorset. However, there is a higher than average proportion of those in very old age. 5.3% are 85+ years compared with 3.9% across Dorset.

- Minster has a relatively low proportion of both vacant properties and second/holiday homes. Overall 97.2% of dwellings have permanent residents.
- Over 19% of households are rented from the council/housing association, the County average is just 12.4%.
- Car ownership is lower than the County average but typical of the towns, 18.5% of households have no car.

- Overall the health of those in Minster division is the same as the County average despite the high proportion of people aged 85+ years.
- Almost 81% said they had good/very good health in Minster, just above the County average. 66.5% of Minster's population described their general health as good, lower than the County average (68.1%).
- More than one in ten people in the area are providing unpaid care to a relative or friend, this is typical of the County.

- Of those who are economically active, the majority are in full-time employment, 52%. Unemployment is slightly higher than the County average, 4.2% compared with 4%.
- Almost 30% of those aged 16+ in Minster division have a higher level qualification, the average across Dorset is 27%.
- Over 43% of those in employment have a high skill occupation, the County average is lower at 40%.
