
## **Electoral Division Profile 2013**



### **Mudeford & Highcliffe Electoral Division**

- Mudeford & Highcliffe Electoral Division is composed of Mudeford and Friars Cliff ward and Highcliffe ward.
- Within the division there is 1 library (central Highcliffe) and 2 schools (both primary).

- The area has the highest proportion of older people in the County, almost 48% are aged 65+ years, this is significantly higher than the County average (25%).

- Mudeford and Highcliffe has a high proportion of second/holiday homes, they account for over 12% of the total housing stock in the area.
- Over 80% of households are owner occupied, higher than average for the County (72.7%).
- The average household size is just 1.9, compared with 2.3 for Dorset, this is partly due to a large number of older people who live alone.

- Of those who are economically active, almost half are in full-time employment. Unemployment in the area is higher than average, 4.4% compared with 4% across Dorset.
- Of those who are economically inactive (aged 16-74) almost 79% are retired.
- Over 26% of those aged 16+ in the division have no qualifications, higher than the County average (21.3%). Almost 29% have a higher level qualification (degree or above), higher than average (27%).
- Mudeford and Highcliffe division has a high proportion of people employed in high skill occupations, 47% compared with 40% across Dorset.
