
# **Electoral Division Profile 2013**



### **Swanage Electoral Division**

Total Population: 9,600 (2011 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: 8,059 (March 2013, PDC)

- Swanage Electoral Division is composed of Swanage North ward and Swanage South ward.
- Within the division there is 1 library and 4 schools (3 primary and 1 middle school).

- Swanage division has a total population of over 9,600.
- There is a high proportion of older people in the division, over 30% are aged 65+ years compared with a County average of 25%.
- There is a particularly high proportion aged 85+ years, 5.3% compared to 3.9% across Dorset.

- Swanage has a high proportion of vacant properties and second/holiday homes, almost 23% of the total housing stock, the County average is just 8.2%.
- Car ownership in the town is lower than the County average, 22% of households do not have a car and just 31% have two or more cars.

- Overall the health of those who live in Swanage is slightly worse than the County average, probably a reflection of the older age profile of the area.
- Almost 24% of the population have a long term illness or disability, the County average is 20%.
- Almost 14% are providing unpaid care to a relative or friend, above the County average of 11.9%.

- The majority of those who are economically active are employed full-time (44.7%). The town has a high proportion who are self-employed, over 22% of the economically active population compared with 18.4% across Dorset.
- Unemployment in Swanage is slightly higher than the County average at 4.6%.
- Of those who are economically inactive (aged 16-74) the majority are retired (68%).
- Swanage has a lower proportion of people employed in high skill occupations (36%) than the County average (40%).
