- Weymouth Town has a high level of unemployment. Just under 8% of the economically active population are unemployed, almost double the County average.
- Of the economically inactive population, almost 26% are permanently sick or disabled, significantly higher than the County average of just 9.7%.
- Just 20% of aged 16+ in the division have a higher qualification (degree or above) much lower than the County average (27%).
- 34% have a high skill occupation, the figure for Dorset is 40%.
