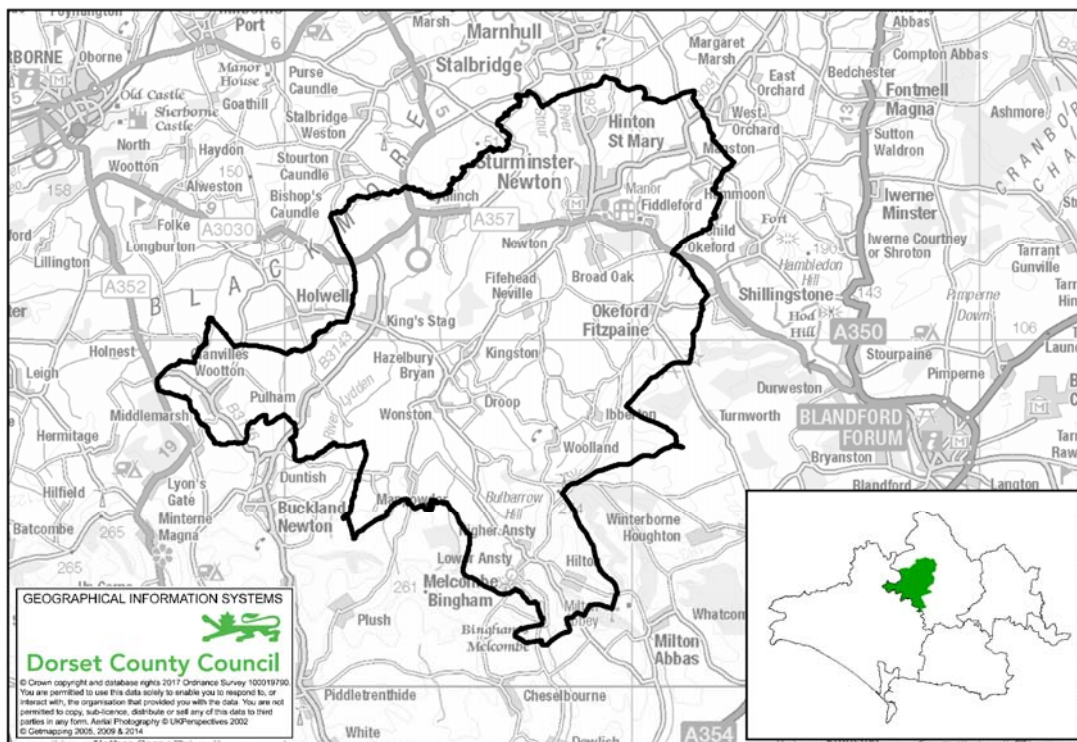


Electoral Division Profile 2017

- Blackmore Vale Electoral Division is composed of the following parishes: Hilton, Woolland, Ibberton, Okeford Fitzpaine, Sturminster Newton, Hinton St.Mary, Manson, Hammoon, Fifehead Neville, Lydlinch, Glanvilles Wootton, Mappowder, Stoke Wake, Pulham, Hazelbury Bryan.
- Within the division there is 1 library. There are also 5 schools (3 primary, 1 secondary and 1 special).
