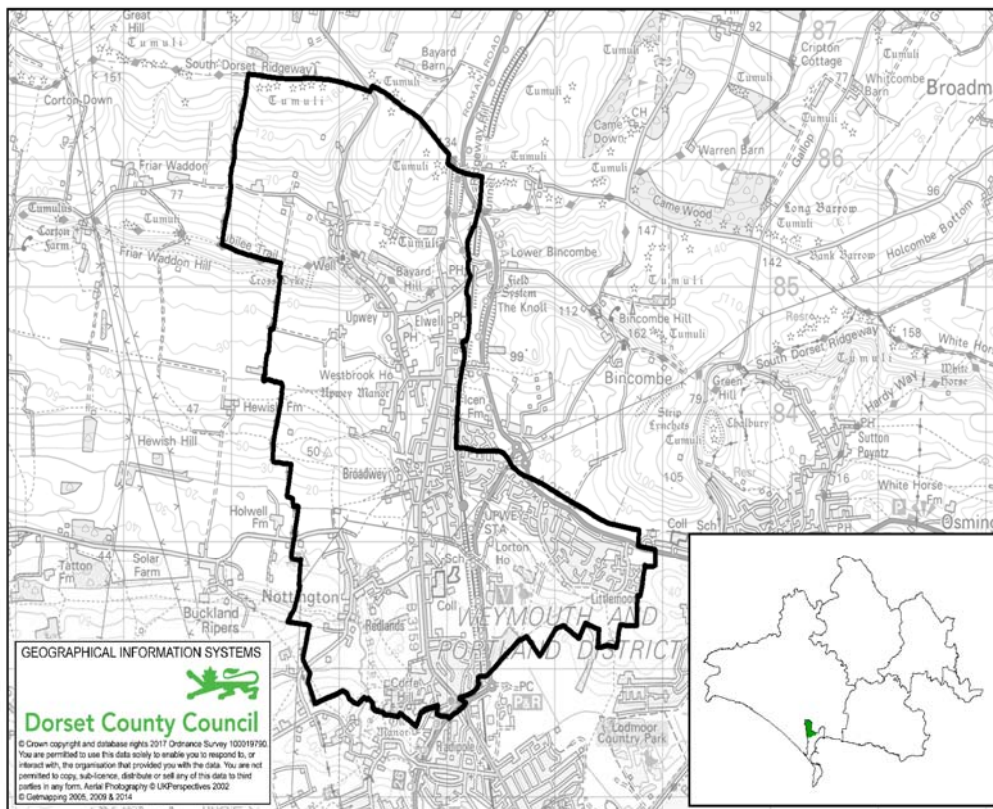


Electoral Division Profile 2017



Broadway Electoral Division

Total Population: **9,100** (2015 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: **7,040** (March, 2017 WPBC)

- Broadway Electoral Division is composed of Wey Valley ward, Upwey and Broadway ward and Littlemoor ward.
- Within the division there are 1 library and 5 schools (3 primary, 1 secondary and 1 Special).
