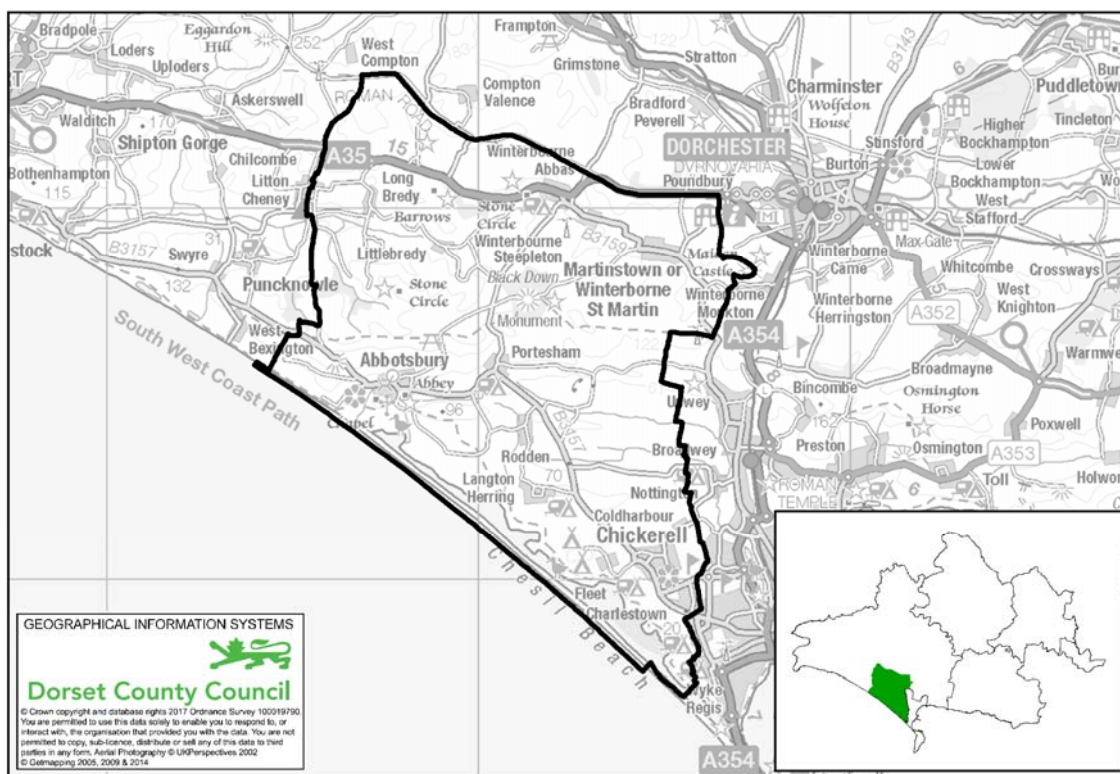


Electoral Division Profile 2017

- Chickerell & Chesil Bank Electoral Division is composed of the following parishes: Chickerell, Fleet, Winterborne St. Martin, Abbotsbury, Portesham, Long Bredy, Kingston Russell, Winterbourne Steepleton, Littlebredy, Winterbourne Abbas and Langton Herring.
- Within the division there are 1 community-run library and 4 schools (1 first school, 2 primary and 1 secondary).
