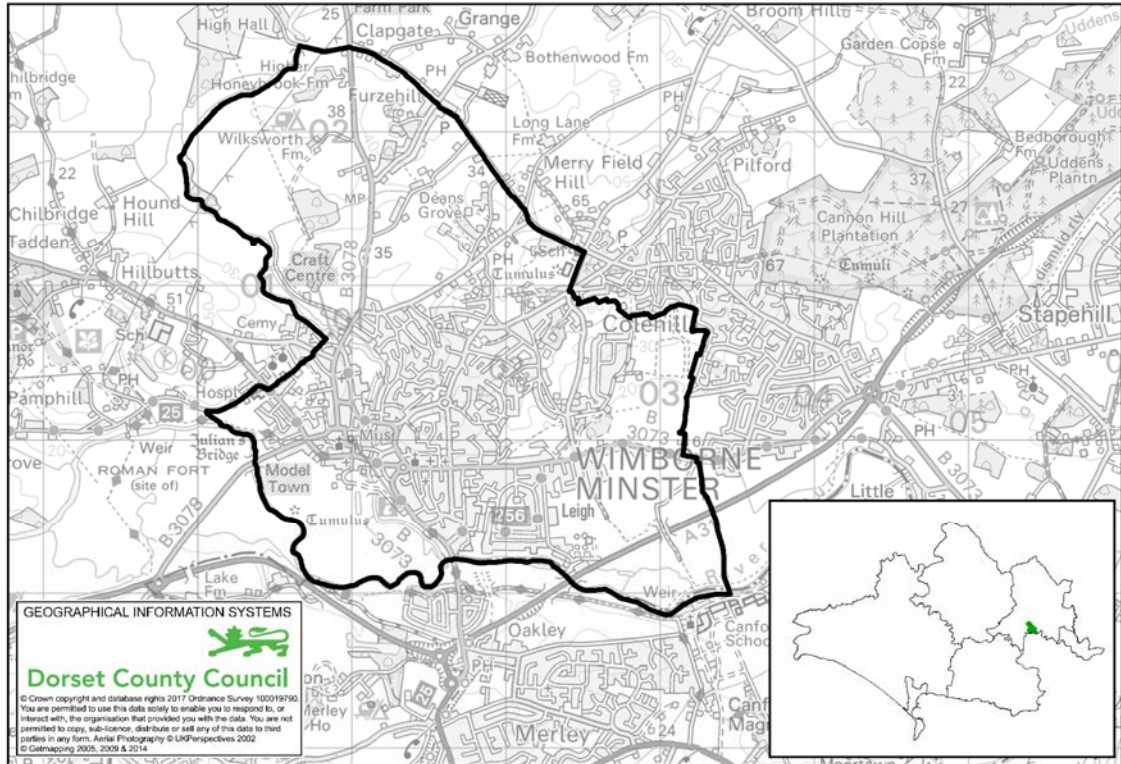


# Electoral Division Profile 2017

- Within the division there is 1 library. There are also 5 schools (2 primary, 2 middle and 1 special).
