

- Overall, the health of those living in Corfe Mullen division is much better than the County average. This is partly due to the younger age profile in the area. Less than 15% have a long term illness or disability, compared with over 20% across Dorset.
- 85.2% described their general health as very good or good and just 3.4% said their health was bad/very bad.
