- Hambledon division has a total population of 11,300.
- The age profile within the division is much younger than the County profile. Just over 20% are aged 0-15 years, compared with 16% across Dorset. This is partly due to the armed forces base within the division (Blandford Camp). The older population (65+) account for almost 19.9% of the population, which is lower than the County figure of almost 27.9%.
