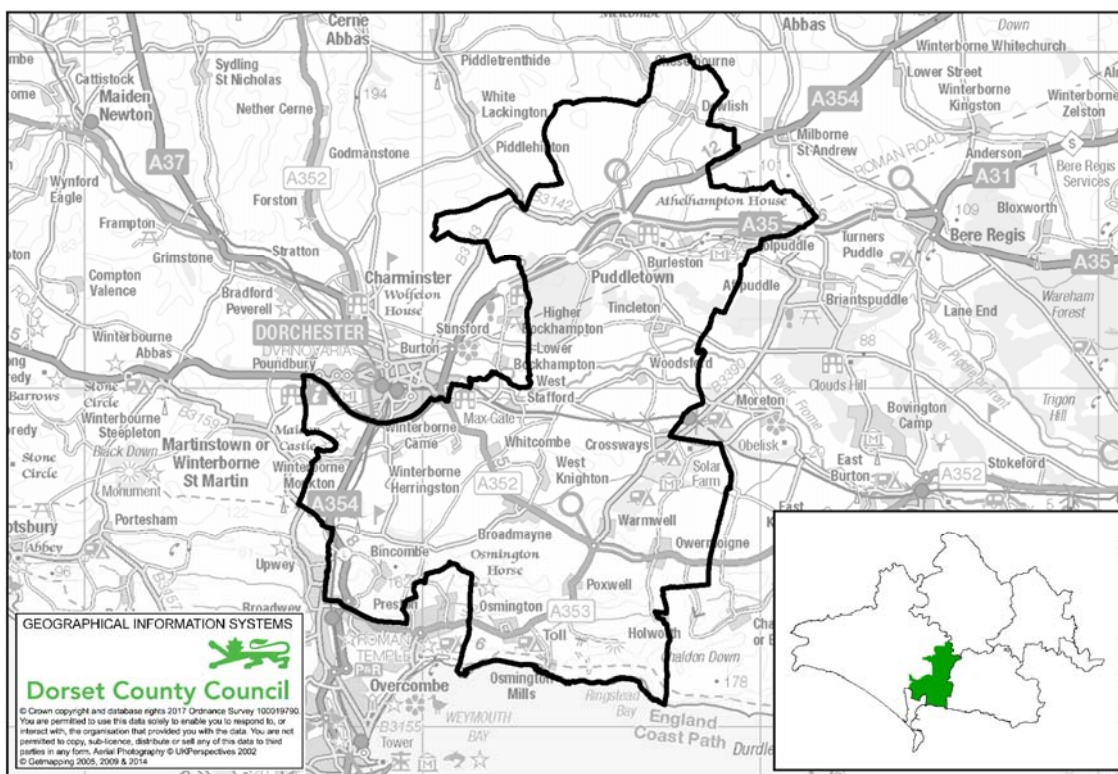


# Electoral Division Profile 2017



## Linden Lea Electoral Division

Total Population: **8,800** (2015 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: **7,051** (March, 2017 WDDC)

- Linden Lea Electoral Division is composed of the following parishes: Tolpuddle, Crossways, Winterborne Came, West Knighton, Winterborne Herringston, West Stafford, Winterborne Monkton, Poxwell, Osmington, Whitcombe, Owermoigne, Warmwell, Bincombe, Broadmayne, Athelhampton, Puddletown, Dewlish, Woodsford, Tincleton and Burleston.
- Within the division there are 2 libraries (one community) and 4 schools (3 first and 1 middle) and 1 Pupil Referral Unit (PRU).
