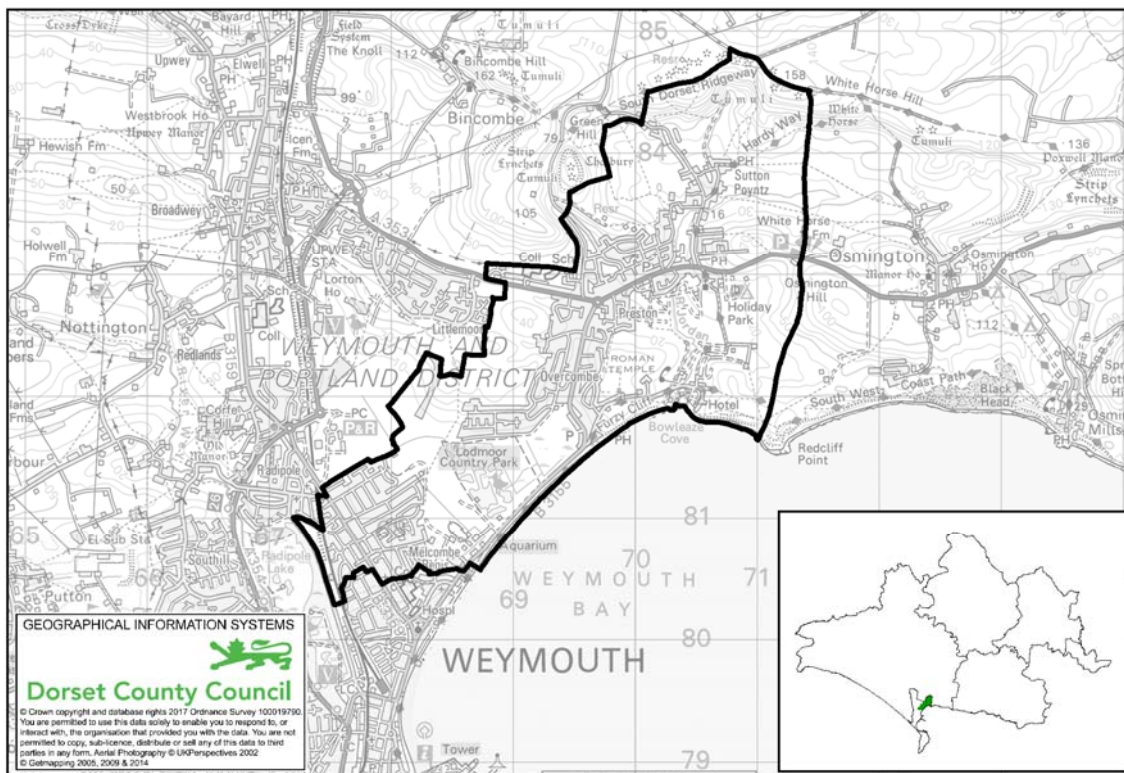


Electoral Division Profile 2017
