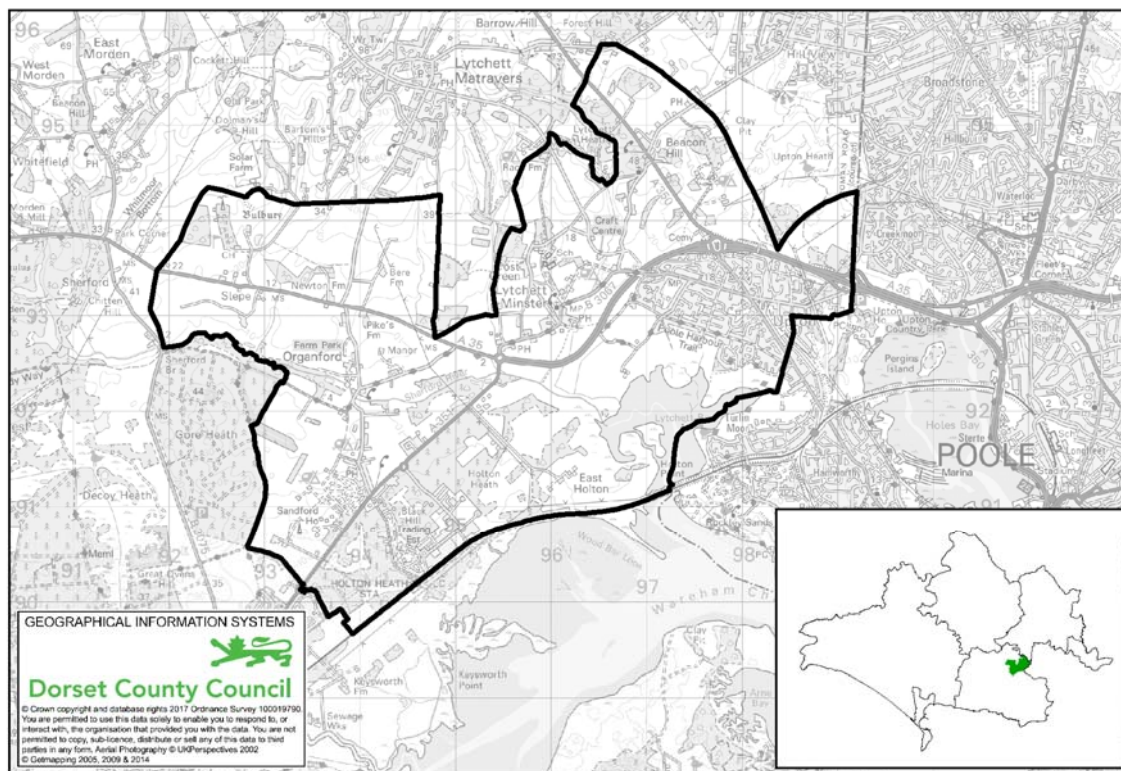


Electoral Division Profile 2017

- No areas are within the top 40% most deprived nationally.
