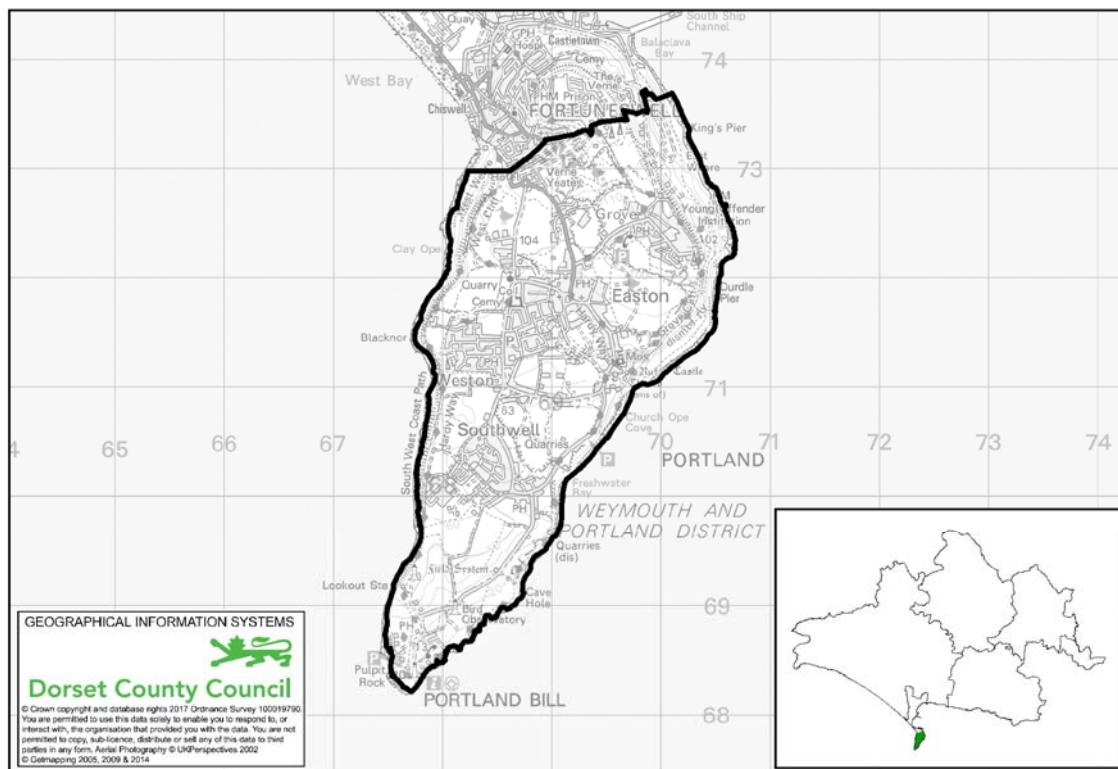


Electoral Division Profile 2017



Portland Tophill Electoral Division

Total Population: **8,900** (2015 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: **6,336**, (Mar 2017 WPBC)

- Portland Tophill Electoral Division is composed of Tophill East ward and Tophill West Ward and Portland CP.
- Within the division there are 1 library and 2 schools (1 primary and Isle of Portland Aldridge Community Academy).
