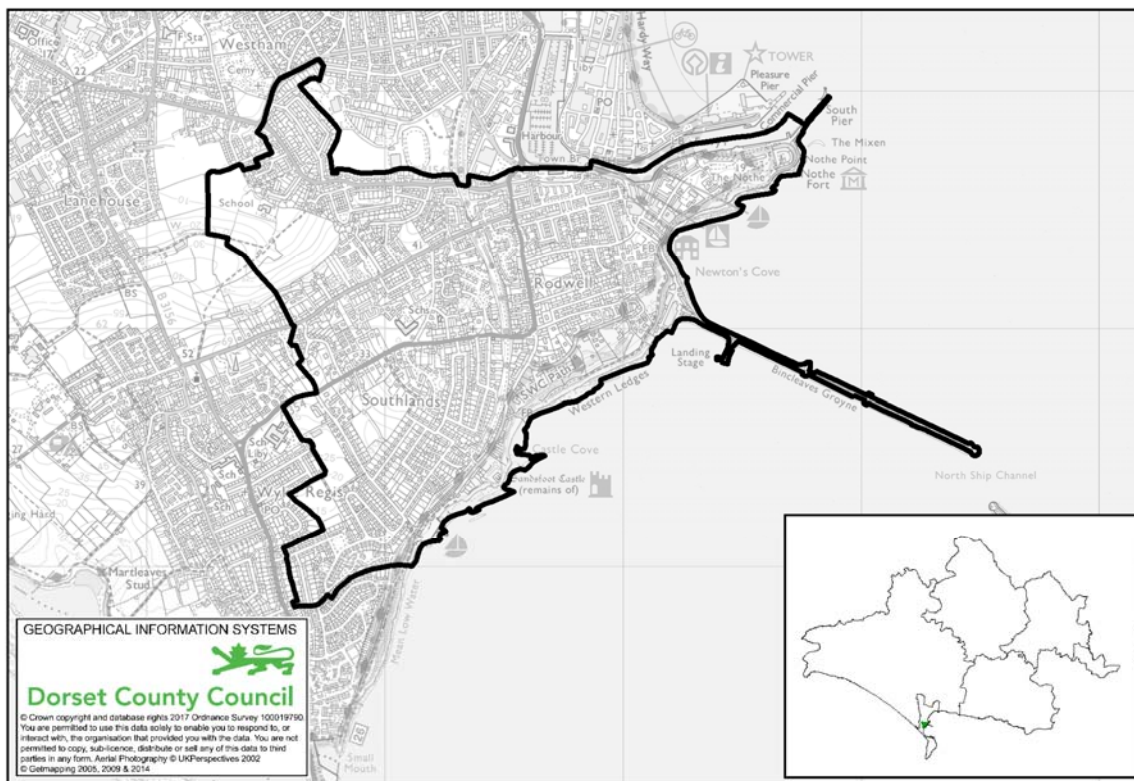


Electoral Division Profile 2017

- Rodwell Electoral Division is composed of Weymouth West ward and Weymouth East ward.
- Within the division there are no libraries (the nearest is in Weymouth Town) and 2 schools (2 primary).
