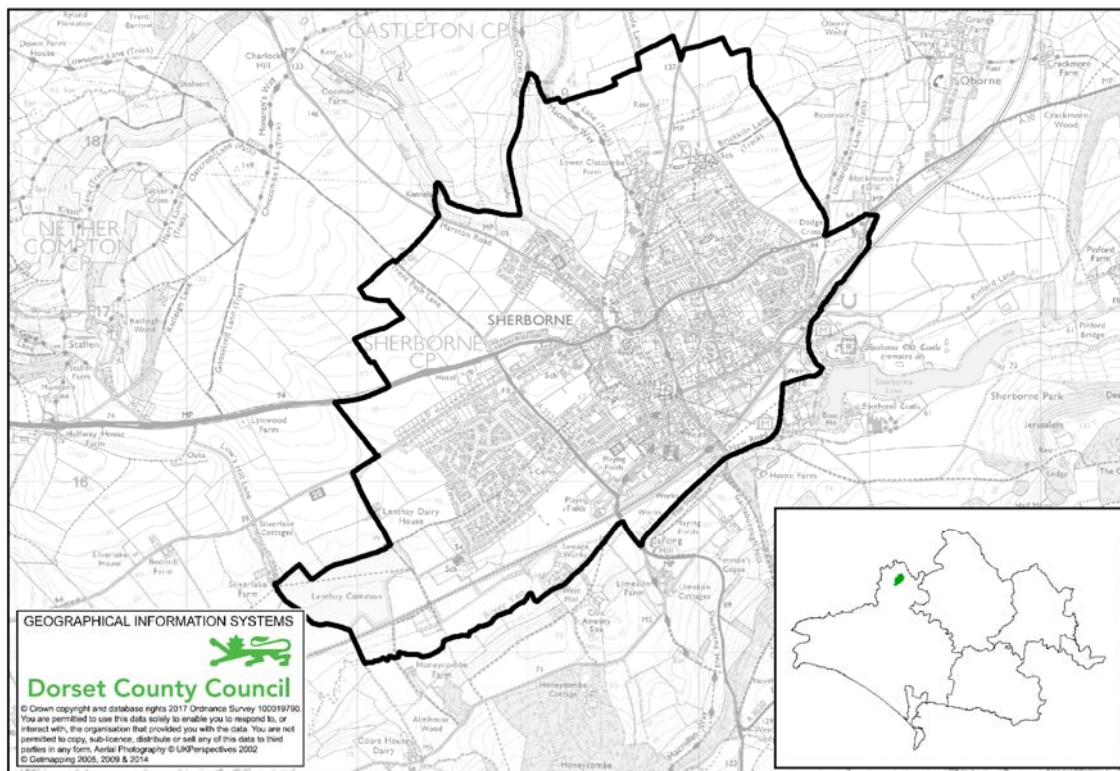


# Electoral Division Profile 2017



## Sherborne Town Electoral Division

Total Population: **9,700** (2015 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: **6,919** (March, 2017 WDDC)

- Sherborne Town Electoral Division is composed of Sherborne.
- Within the division there are 1 library, 3 schools (2 primary, 1 secondary) and 1 Pupil Referral Unit (PRU).
