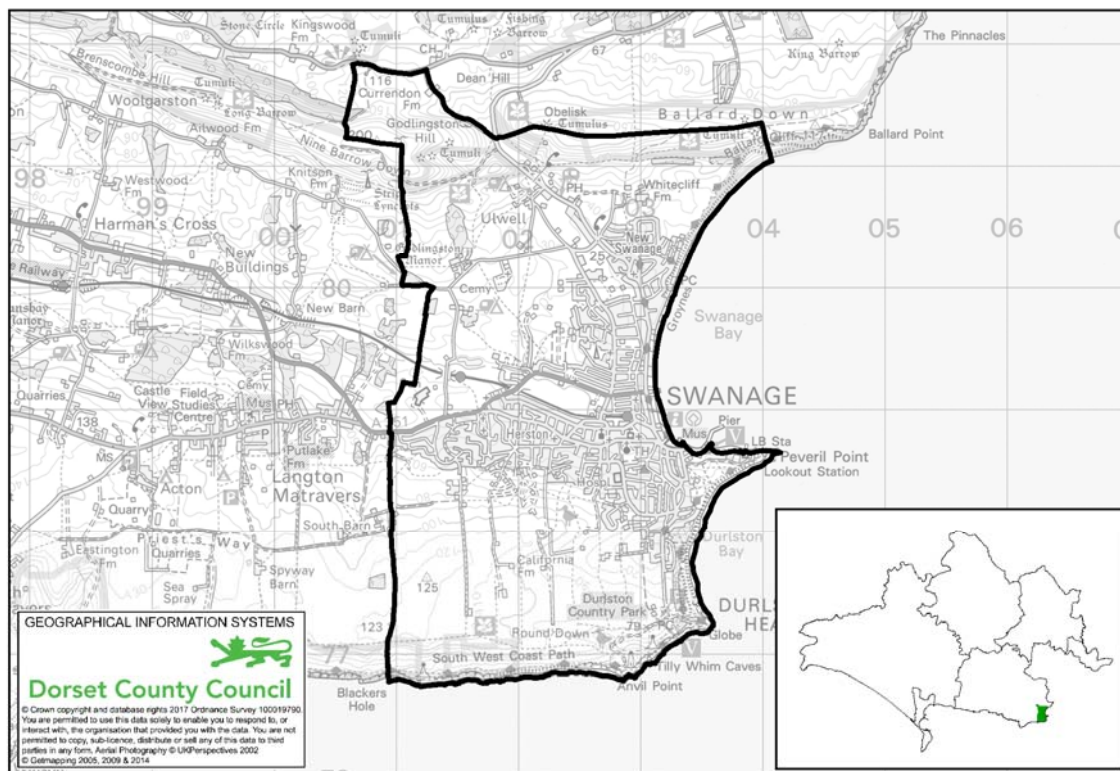


Electoral Division Profile 2017

- Swanage Electoral Division is composed of only 1 parish, Swanage.
- Within the division there is 1 library and 4 schools (3 primary and 1 secondary free school).

- Swanage Herston falls within the top 40% most deprived nationally.
