
# **Electoral Division Profile 2017**

- Verwood Electoral Division is composed of the following parishes: Horton, Woodlands and Alderholt.
- Within the division there is 1 library. There are also 5 schools (4 primary and 1 middle).

- Verwood division has a total population of 17,400 and is represented by two councillors.
- The age profile within the division is slightly younger than the County average.
- The proportion of people aged 0-15 years is slightly higher in the division, 17.7% compared with 16% across Dorset.
- 65 and over account for 25.6% of the divisions population, lower than for Dorset (27.9%).
