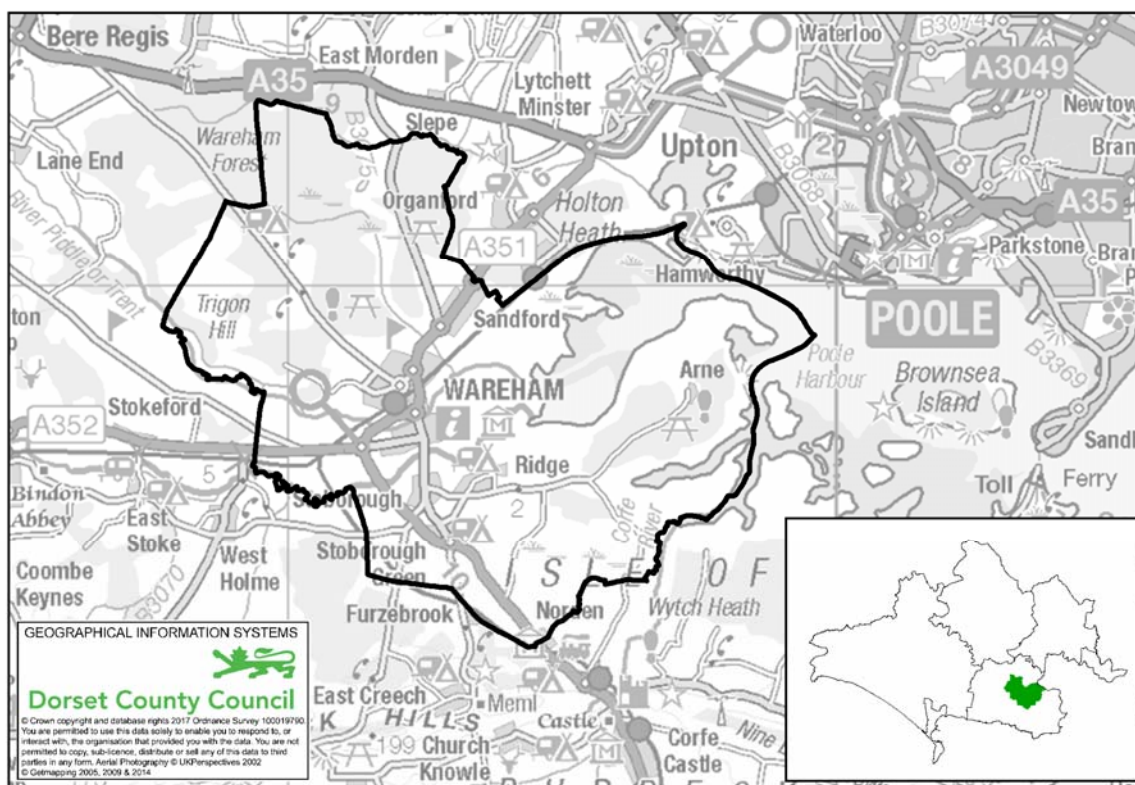


Electoral Division Profile 2017



Wareham Electoral Division

Total Population: **9,000** (2015 Mid Year Estimate, DCC) Number of Electors: **7,498** (March, 2017 PDC)

- Wareham Electoral Division is composed of the Arne, Wareham St. Martin and Wareham Town parishes.
- Within the division there are 1 library and 4 schools (3 primary and 1 secondary).
