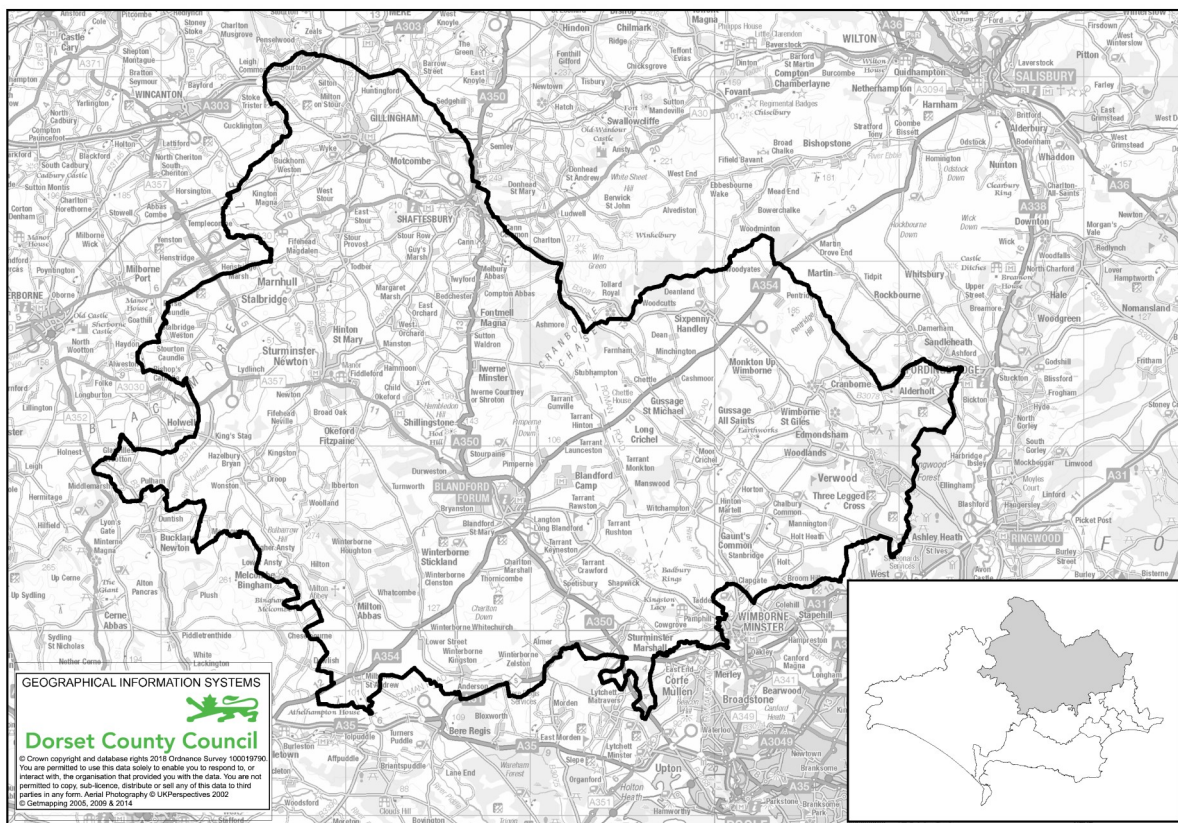

- North Dorset Parliamentary Constituency Area has a total population of 98,880.
- The area has a slightly smaller working age population than the regional and national average with 57% aged 16-64 compared to 61% across the South West. The proportion of population aged 65+ is larger than both the South West and England & Wales at 26%.
