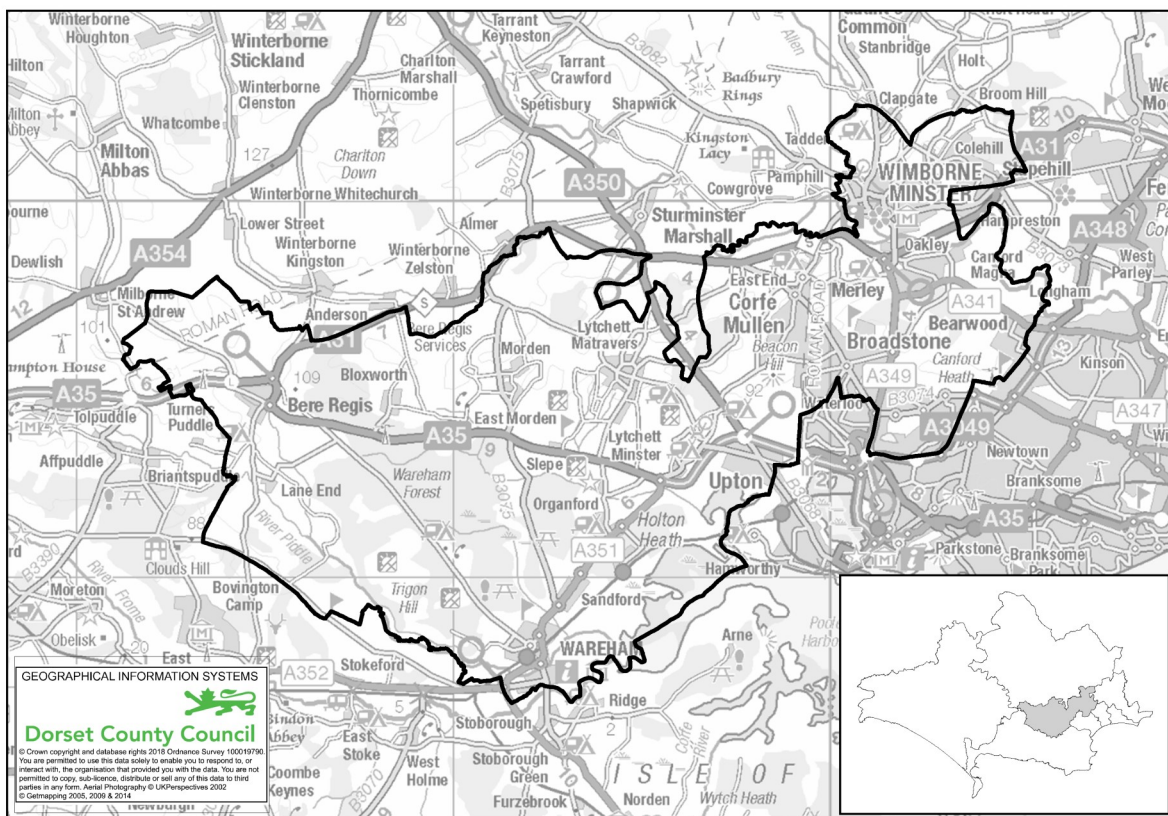

- Within the Parliamentary Constituency Area there are 9 libraries and 33 schools (21 primary, 4 middle, 5 secondary, 3 special).

- Mid Dorset & North Poole Parliamentary Constituency Area has a total population of 82,740.
- 57% of the areas population are working age (16-64yrs), lower than the regional average of 61% and even lower than the national average of 63%. Those aged 65+ account for almost a quarter of the area's population; larger than both regional and national figures.
