

Within Christchurch Parliamentary Constituency Area there are four Libraries - two owned and run by Dorset Council and two by BCP Council. There are also 25 Schools of which: 17 are Primary (seven in Dorset Council and ten in BCP), there are two Middle schools (both in DC), four Secondary schools (three in BCP and one in DC) one Free School (in DC) and one Learning Centre in DC.

Note: Part of Constituency is in Dorset Council and part is in BCP. Data on the profile covers the whole constituency area

Proportionally the area has fewer under 16s than the South West or national average. It also has a much smaller proportion of working-age population than the regional and national average with 51% aged 16-64 compared to 61% across the South West. The proportion of the population aged 65+ is much larger at 35% compared to a regional average of 22% and national average of 19%.
