

Notice of Confirmation of a Modification Order

Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Dorset County Council County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement of Rights of Way

Dorset County Council (Upgrading Bridleway 7, Puddletown (Blind Lane) to Restricted Byway) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2014

On 16 May 2014 Dorset County Council confirmed (without modification) the above named order as unopposed.

The effect of the order as confirmed will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading Bridleway 7, Puddletown (Blind Lane) in the West Dorset District to Restricted Byway:

From its junction with the A354 Blandford Road at Basan Hill, Puddletown at SY 76549594, a double hedged, unsurfaced path west north west to its junction with the unclassified road from Druce to Dewlish at SY 76019606. Width: SY 76549594 – 6 metres, widening to 10 metres at SY 76359600, SY 76359600 – SY 76199603 – 10 metres, narrowing to 6 metres at SY 76019606. Limitations: None.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Reception, County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester during normal office hours. Copies of the order and map may be bought there at the price of £10.00. (Cheques should be made payable to Dorset County Council.)

The order came into effect on 16 May 2014. If any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, you may within six weeks from 12 June 2014, make an application to the High Court.
