

Notice of Confirmation of a Modification Order Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Dorset Council County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement of Rights of Way

Dorset Council (Bridleway 8, Turnworth to be upgraded to Restricted Byway) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2025

On 28 March 2025 Dorset Council confirmed (without modification) the above-named order as unopposed.

The effect of the order as confirmed will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:

Bridleway 8, Turnworth

Upgrading to Restricted Byway Bridleway 8, Turnworth from Bridleway 14, Okeford Fitzpaine at ST 80440875, north east along a crushed stone track to ST 80560888, east north east to its junction with Footpath 57 at ST 80750897, continuing north east between farm buildings at ST 81000919, then continuing east north east along the south boundary of the Okeford Hill car park and picnic site to its junction with the C32 County Road at ST 81250932.

Limitation ST 81250932 Bridle gate.

The order came into effect on 28 March 2025. If any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, you may within six weeks from 18 September 2025, make an application to the High Court.
