**Dorset County Council (Part of Bridleway 27, Puddletown known as Gaddy's Lane
to be upgraded to Restricted Byway)
Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2014**

This Order is made by Dorset County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(ii) namely, that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description and section 53 (3)(c)(iii) that any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Dorset County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 15 July 2014.
2. The County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "Dorset County Council (Part of Bridleway 27, Puddletown known as Gaddy's Lane to be upgraded to Restricted Byway) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2014".

SCHEDULE

(The points specified relate to the map attached to the Order and their positions are identified by national grid references)

Part I

Modification of definitive map Description of way to be upgraded

A – B – C Part of Bridleway 27, Puddletown, known as Gaddy's Lane from a point west
– D – E south west of Troy Town Farm at the edge of Yellowham Wood at point A (SY 73329389), north north east along a grassed track to point B (SY 73539429), then along the track hedged on both sides north to point C (SY 73539430), continuing north east to its junction with Bridleway 39 and Bridleway 26, Puddletown (known as Charminster Lane), at point D (SY 73559431), then north east and north north east along an earth surfaced track hedged on both sides to its junction with Waterston Lane B3142 at point E (SY 74259507).
Width: Between points A (SY 73329389) and B (SY 73539429) – 5.4 metres at point A, (widening to 14.4 metres) and narrowing to 3.7 metres at point B. Between points B (SY 73539429) and C (SY 73539430) – 3.7 metres, widening to 6.6 metres. Between points C (SY 73539430) and D (SY 73559431) – 6.6 metres, widening to 11.5 metres. Between points D (SY 73559431) and E (SY 74259507) – 9 metres, narrowing to 4.7 metres and widening to 12 metres at point E (SY 74259507).

Modification of definitive statement Variation of particulars of way

Bridleway 27, Puddletown, known as Gaddy's Lane in the West Dorset District:

Delete:

From: 730932 To: 742950
Dorchester Road at Yellowham Wood via Gaddys Lane to road at Chine Hill.

Add:

From: 730932 To: SY 74259507
From Dorchester Road at Yellowham Wood, via Gaddy's Lane, north east through woodland to SY 73329389 and north north east, along a grassed track to SY 73539429, then along the track hedged on both sides north to SY 73539430, continuing north east to its junction with Bridleway 39 and Bridleway 26, Puddletown (known as Charminster Lane) at SY 73559431, then north east and north north east along an earth surfaced track hedged on both sides to its junction with Waterston Lane B3142 at SY 74259507 at Chine Hill.
Width: Between SY 73329389 and SY 73539429 – 5.4 metres at SY 73329389, (widening to 14.4 metres) and narrowing to 3.7 metres at SY 73539429. Between SY 73539429 and SY 73539430 – 3.7 metres, widening to 6.6 metres. Between SY 73539430 and SY 73559431 – 6.6 metres, widening to 11.5 metres. Between SY 73559431 and SY 74259507 – 9 metres, narrowing to 4.7 metres and widening to 12 metres at SY 74259507.
