

**Notice of Modification Order**

**Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981**

**Dorset County Council  
County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement of Rights of Way**

**Dorset County Council (Part of Bridleway 27, Puddletown known as Gaddy's Lane  
to be upgraded to Restricted Byway)  
Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2014**

The above Order, made on 15 August 2014, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading Part of Bridleway 27, Puddletown, known as Gaddy's Lane and varying the particulars relating to that route in the West Dorset District to Restricted Byway:

Gaddy's Lane from a point west south west of Troy Town Farm at the edge of Yellowham Wood at SY 73329389, north north east along a grassed track to SY 73539429, then along the track hedged on both sides north to SY 73539430, continuing north east to its junction with Bridleway 39 and Bridleway 26, Puddletown (known as Charminster Lane), at SY 73559431, then north east and north north east along an earth surfaced track hedged on both sides to its junction with Waterston Lane B3142 at SY 74259507. Width: Between SY 73329389 and SY 73539429 – 5.4 metres at SY 73329389, (widening to 14.4 metres) and narrowing to 3.7 metres at SY 73539429. Between SY 73539429 and SY 73539430 – 3.7 metres, widening to 6.6 metres. Between SY 73539430 and SY 73559431 – 6.6 metres, widening to 11.5 metres. Between SY 73559431 and SY 74259507 – 9 metres, narrowing to 4.7 metres and widening to 12 metres at SY 74259507.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at Reception, County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester during normal office hours. Copies of the Order and map may be bought there for £10.00. (Cheques should be made payable to Dorset County Council.)

Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Vanessa Penny, Definitive Map Team Manager, Environment and the Economy Directorate, Dorset County Council, County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester, Dorset DT1 1XJ (Ref: RW/T401) not later than 24 October 2014, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Any letters received will be made available for public inspection.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Dorset County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
