

Notice of Modification Order

Section 53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement of Rights of Way

Dorset County Council (Bridleway 36, Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge (Bowling Green Lane) to be upgraded to Restricted Byway and a Restricted Byway to be added from Bridleway 36 to Hampshire County Boundary in Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2016

The above Order, made on 17 May 2016, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by upgrading Bridleway 36, Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge (Bowling Green Lane) and adding a Restricted Byway from Bridleway 36 (new Restricted Byway 36) to the Hampshire county boundary at Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge in the East Dorset District as follows:

Bridleway 36, Sixpenny Handley & Pentridge

(To be numbered Restricted Byway 36)

From its junction with Bowling Green Lane and Footpath 54 at Peaked Post at SU 03091830, north east along an earth and grass surfaced track (known as Bowling Green Lane), hedged on both sides, to its junction with Bridleway 37 at SU 03191843, continuing north east along the track and through a small area of trees to SU 03511881, then turn east north east to its junction with Bridleway 40 (Earthpits Lane) at SU 03911889. Continue east north east along a grass surfaced track to its junction with Restricted Byway 59 at the north western corner of a field at SU 04121893 and continuing east across the field to the Hampshire county boundary south west of Martin Down at SU 04341894. The width varies: 8 metres at SU 03091830, 5 metres at SU 03191843, 6.5 metres at SU 03511881, 10.6 metres at SU 03911889, 4.3 metres at SU 04121893 and 3.9 metres at SU 04341894.

Add a Restricted Byway

(To be numbered Restricted Byway 59)

From its junction with Bridleway 36 (to be upgraded to Restricted Byway), in the north western corner of a field, at SU 04121893, east north east along a grass surfaced track via its junction with Bridleway 41 to the Hampshire county boundary south west of Martin Down at SU 04331897. Width: 4.3 metres at SU 04121893 and 4.6 metres at SU 04331897.

A copy of the Order and the Order map may be seen free of charge at Reception, County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester during normal office hours. Any representation or objection relating to the Order must be sent in writing to Phil Hobson, Senior Definitive Map Officer, Dorset Highways, Environment and the Economy Directorate, Dorset County Council, County Hall, Colliton Park, Dorchester, Dorset, DT1 1XJ (Ref: RW/T403) not later than 5 November 2016, and applicants are requested to state the grounds on which it is made. Any letters received will be made available for public inspection.

If no representations or objections are duly made to the Order, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Dorset County Council, instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs may itself confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
