**Dorset County Council (Part of Bridleway 43, Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge to be  
Upgraded to Restricted Byway)  
Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2016**

This Order is made by Dorset County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(ii) namely, that a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description and section 53(3)(c)(iii) namely, that any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Dorset County Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 11 April 2016.
2. The County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "Dorset County Council (Part of Bridleway 43, Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge to be Upgraded to Restricted Byway) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2016".

## SCHEDULE

(The points specified relate to the map attached to the Order and their positions are identified by national grid references)

### Part I

#### **Modification of definitive map Description of way to be upgraded**

Part of Bridleway 43, Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge in the East Dorset District:  
(To be renumbered Restricted Byway 60)

- A – B – C From its junction with Bridleway 40 and proposed Restricted Byway 61  
– D (known as Earthpits Lane), west south west of Whitey Top Cottage at point A (SU 03721812), east along a tarmac surfaced path, hedged on both sides, passing to the south of Whitey Top Cottage and Whitey Top Farm to point B (SU 04091808). Continue east, crossing into a field and across the field boundary at point C (SU 04191808) and east, across the field to its junction with Bridleway 42 and the unaffected part of Bridleway 43 at point D (SU 04251808).  
The width varies: 5.8 metres at point A (SU 03721812), 7.6 metres at point B (SU 04091808), 4 metres at point C (SU 04191808) widening to 11 metres at point D (SU 04251808).

### Part II

#### **Modification of definitive statement Variation of particulars of way**

##### **Delete:**

Bridleway 43, Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge

From: 037181 To: 047179

Earthpits Lane eastwards to join Path No 14.

##### **Add:**

Bridleway 43, Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge

From: SU 04251808 To: 047179

From its junction with Bridleway 42 and Restricted Byway 60, east of Whitey Top Farm eastwards to join Bridleway 45.

##### **Add:**

Restricted Byway 60, Sixpenny Handley and Pentridge

From: SU 03721812 To: SU 04251808

From its junction with Bridleway 40 and Restricted Byway 61 (known as Earthpits Lane), west south west of Whitey Top Cottage, east along a tarmac surfaced path, hedged on both sides, passing to the south of Whitey Top Cottage and Whitey Top Farm at SU 04091808. Continue east, crossing into a field and across the field boundary at SU 04191808 and east, across the field to its junction with Bridleway 42 and Bridleway 43.

Width: 5.8 metres at SU 03721812, 7.6 metres at SU 04091808, 4 metres at SU 04191808, widening to 11 metres at SU 04251808).
