CHILD OKEFORD

HISTORY

The wood had been owned by farmer Raymond Buckland since the 1960's and the footpath had been used before that time and then regularly up until February 2015. Mr. Buckland knew that people were using the footpath but did not obstruct it or put up notices to stop them.

Mr. Buckland died in December 2013 and the wood was auctioned in September 2014 and bought by Mr. Wellstead and Ms. Baggaley.

In February 2015 the wood was securely fenced with barbed wire and padlocked gates.

People who had enjoyed a walk through this pleasant wood for over 20 years were no longer allowed. The path through the wood provided a much more enjoyable route from Child Okeford up to Hambledon Hill than using the section of the bridleway that runs alongside. This is regularly used by horse riders, farm vehicles and animals and is often very muddy.

The enclosed pictures show the new gate at the lower entrance to the footpath (Point A on the map) and the fencing at the top end closing off the upper entrance (Point B on the map).

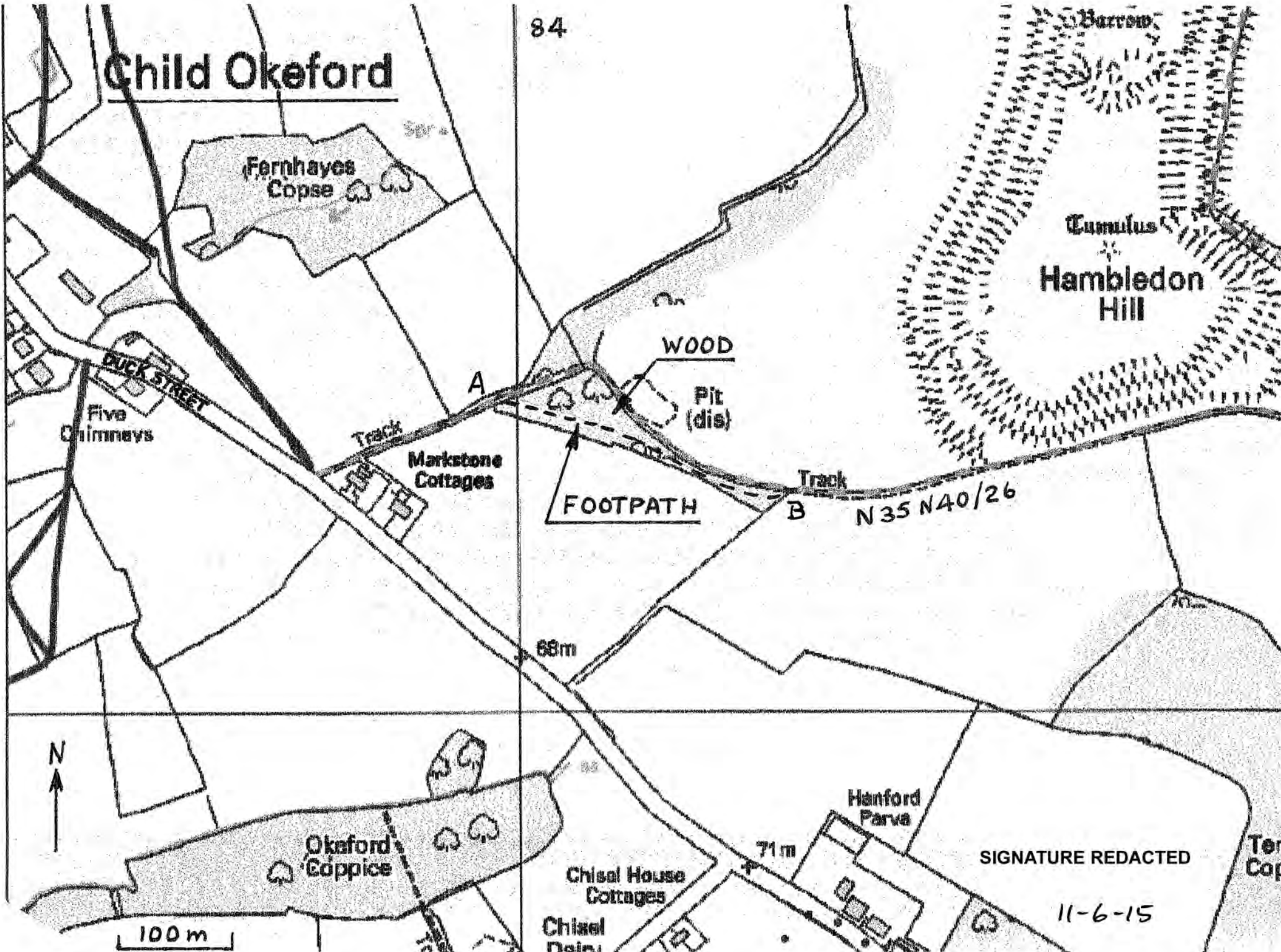

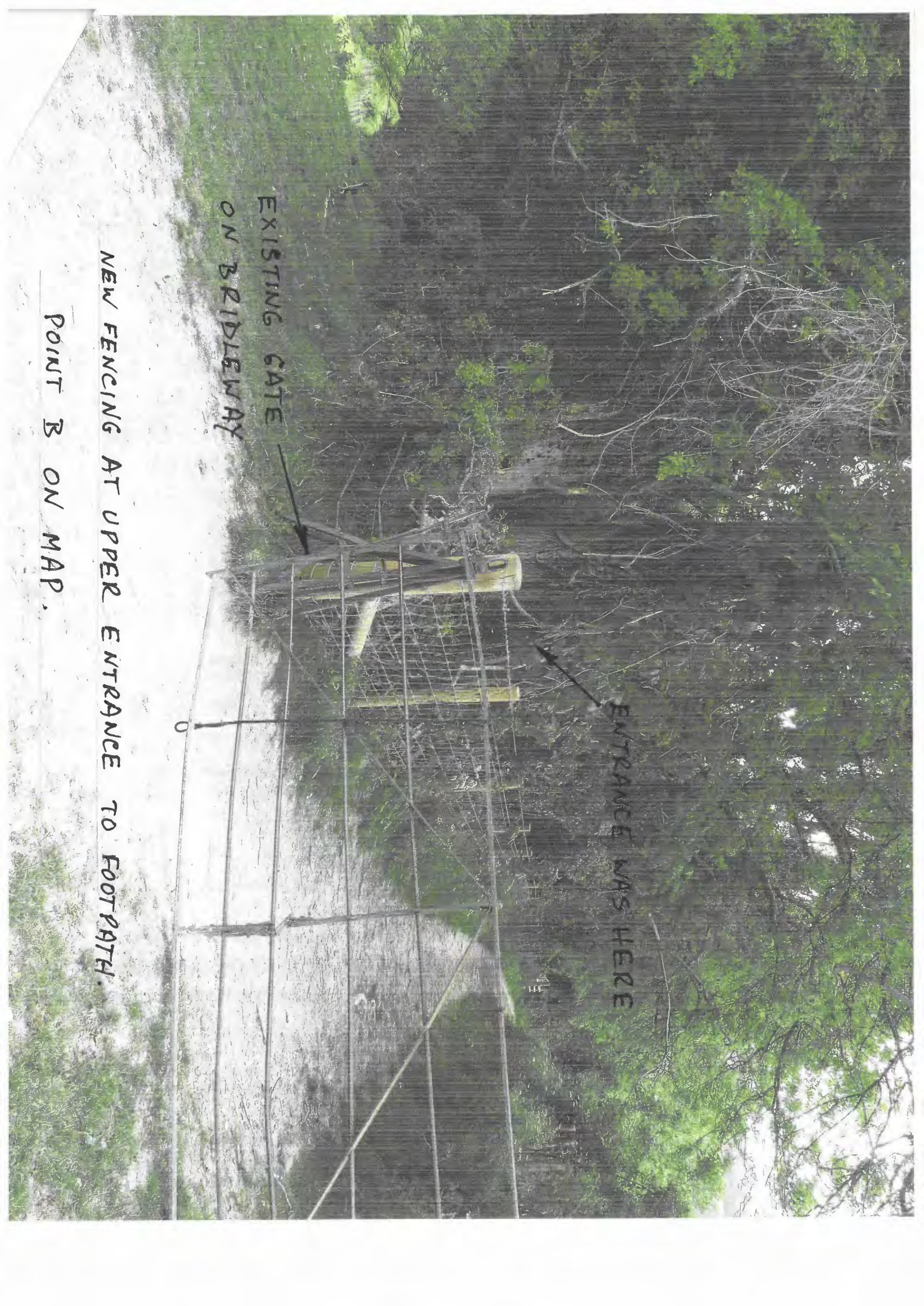
