Upgrading Trill Lane (footpath N 10/16) to a restricted byway from point A (approximately ST 5893 1311) on the county road near Langford Bridge, to point B, the north western end of Cole's Lane (approximately ST 5823 1208), and add a restricted byway along Cole's Lane from point B to point C (approximately ST 5867 1145) the north western end of the of the unclassified county road in the parish of Yetminster.
