



## **Notice of Modification Order**

#### **County of Dorset Definitive Map and Statement of Rights of Way**

#### **Dorset Council (A Footpath at Third Cliff Walk, West Cliff, West Bay, Bridport) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2025**

The above Order, made on 25 April 2025, if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them a Footpath in the Bridport Parish.

Commencing at the junction with definitive bridleway W1/105 at SY 4581 9070 on West Cliff Road, south-west to SY 4576 9062, continuing south-west to SY 4574 9059 at the junction with definitive footpath W1/106.

Width: 3.4 metres between SY 4581 9070 and SY 4576 9062, narrowing to 3.2 metres to SY 4574 9059.

If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State, any representations or objections which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be sent with it.
