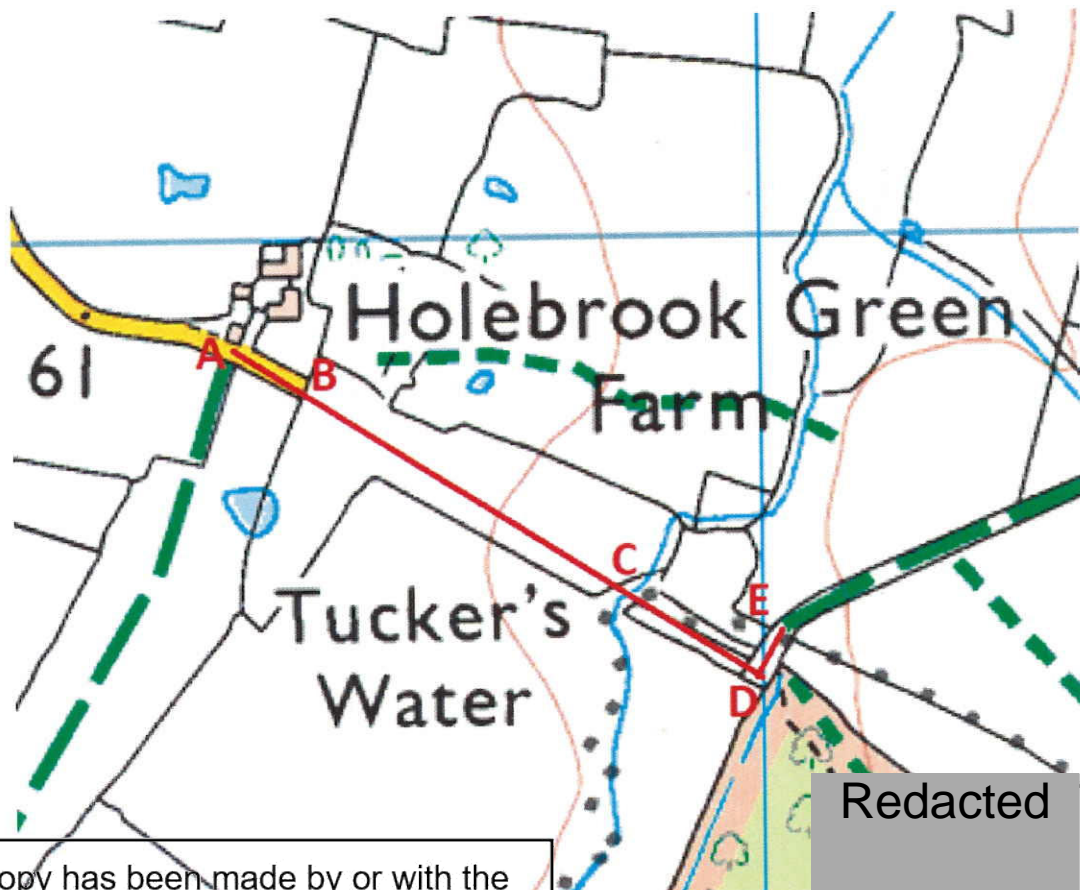


Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Dorset

Map accompanying the DMMO application for the route in the parishes of Lydlinch and Fifehead Neville which runs from Point A (at approximately ST 7468 1193) at the northern end of definitive bridleway N44/15 on Holebrook Lane, D 31802, along this unclassified county road, coloured dark blue on the Dorset Explorer website, to Point B (at approximately ST 7472 1190) at the north western end of the unmade unclassified county road (coloured turquoise and dark green on the Dorset Explorer website), south-eastwards along this unmade unclassified county road to Point C (at approximately ST 7493 1178) at the stream on the parish boundary between Lydlinch and Fifehead Neville, then extending east - southeastwards in Fifehead Neville parish on an unrecorded track through Holebrook Water to Point D (at approximately ST 7500 1174 where it meets the corner in the definitive footpath N 37/1, and turns north-eastwards along definitive footpath N37/1 to Point E (at approximately ST 7501 1175) on the parish boundary where it meets the end of the definitive bridleway N44/5 in Lydlinch.

The application is for the route from A through to D is for an addition, and the section from D to E is for an upgrade.



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
