Upgrading to a bridleway part of footpath N 62/13 from Point A (at approximately ST 8058 2404) to Point B (at approximately ST 8103 2400).
Adding a bridleway from Point B (at approximately ST 8103 2400) past High Grove Farm to Point C (at approximately ST 8165 2383).
Upgrading to a bridleway the footpath N 62/2 from Point C (at approximately ST 8165 2383) to Point D (at approximately ST 8156 2366) and continues south-westwards along Common Lane to Point E (at approximately ST 8146 2342), where it joins the public road, all in the parish of East Stour.
