I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a bridleway along the route starting at Point A (at approximately ST 5958 1759) at the end of definitive bridleway N 23/1, extending south-eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 5961 1757) at the north western end of the unmade unclassified county road, and continuing in the same direction to Point C (at approximately ST 5973 1750) at the corner in the district road, west of the road through the village, all in the parish of Nether Compton, to be shown as a bridleway. This route is all in the parish of Nether Compton.
