I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route known as Kitton Lane starting from Point A (at approximately ST 6031 1701) on the county road at Stallen, extending northwards to Point B (at approximately ST 6038 1755) at the eastern end of definitive bridleway N 23/8, continuing eastwards and north-eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 6058 1784) to the south eastern end of definitive bridleway N 23/7, then eastwards to Point D (at approximately ST 6096 1772), Tuckers Cross, at the junction with definitive bridleways N 23/6 and N 23/15. This route is all in the parish of Nether Compton.
