I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route known as Underdown Lane, starting at Point A (at approximately ST 6473 1745) Dodge Cross, on the A30 opposite the northern end of definitive bridleway N 2/21, extending northwards to Point B (at approximately ST 6474 1751) at the southern end of definitive bridleway N 7/17, and continues northwards and eastward to Point C (at approximately ST 6524 1849) at the southern end of definitive bridleway N25/5, then continues eastwards to Point D (at approximately ST 6536 1850) at the western end of the county road in Osborne. The route starts in Sherborne parish and passes through what is now Castleton parish, and the north eastern end is in Osborne parish.
