I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route which extends from Point A (at approximately SY 4267 9502) at the junction of definitive bridleways W 18/64 and W 18/63 and extends southwards to Point B (at approximately SY 4303 9460) at the eastern end of definitive bridleway W 18/59, continues southwards to Point C passing the eastern end of definitive bridleway W 18/56 at approximately SY 4314 9448, and then the western end of definitive bridleway W 18/55 at approximately SY 4317 9446, then continues southwards to Point D (at approximately SY 4342 9385 at Quarry Cross then on to Point E (at approximately SY 4367 9327) to the county road at Rock Hopper at the end of the county road north of Quarr Lane Farm, all in the parish of Symondsburry.
