The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way in Dorset

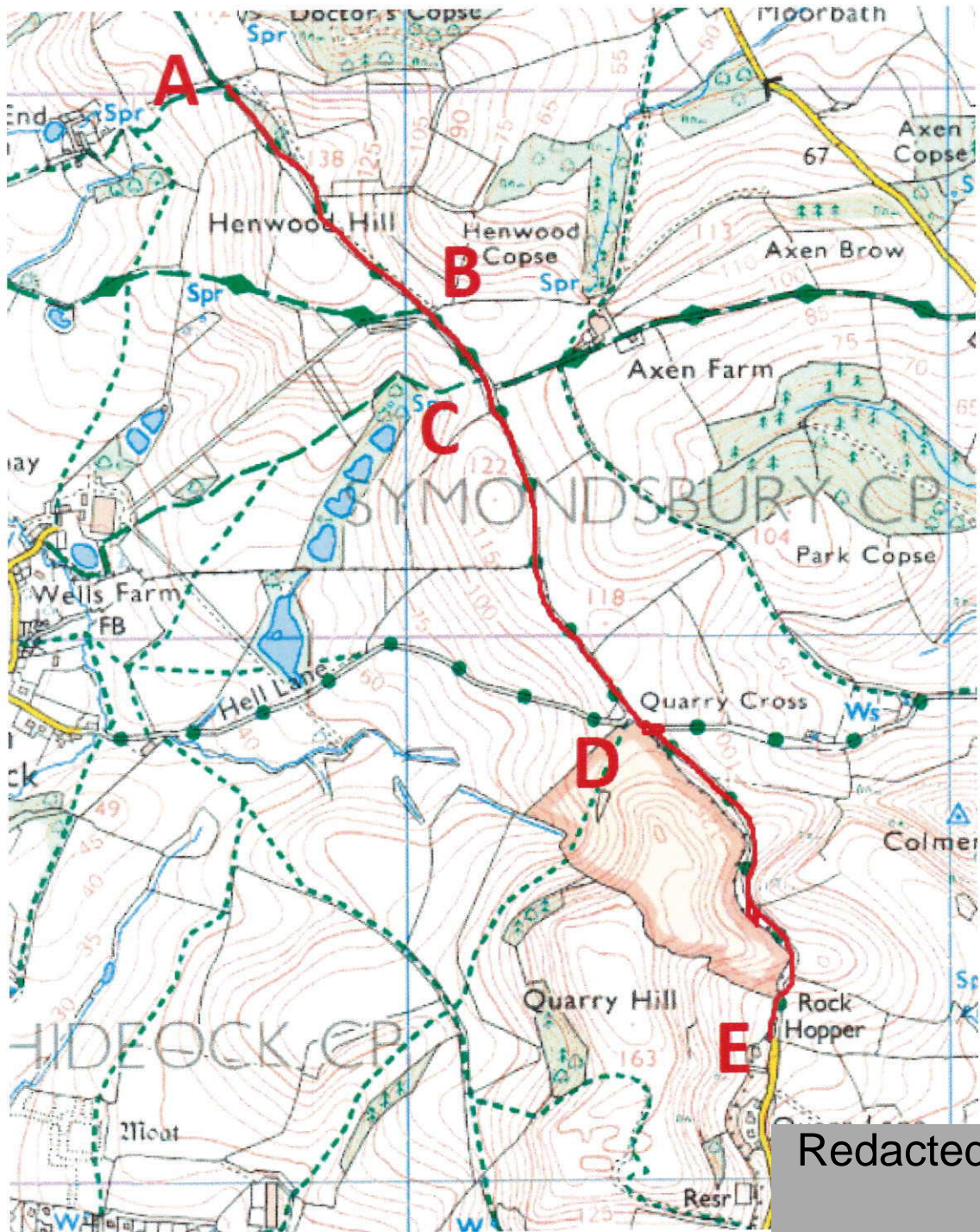
Map accompanying the DMMO application to add a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route shown on the plan below:

For the route extending from Point A (at approximately SY 4267 9502) at the junction of definitive bridleways W 18/64 and W 18/63 and extending southwards to Point B (at approximately SY 4303 9460) at the eastern end of definitive bridleway W 18/59, continuing southwards to Point C passing the eastern end of definitive bridleway W 18/56 at approximately SY 4314 9448, and then the western end of definitive bridleway W 18/55 at approximately SY 4317 9446, then continues southwards to Point D (at approximately SY 4342 9385 at Quarry Cross then on to Point E (at approximately SY 4367 9327) to the county road at Rock Hopper at the end of the county road north of Quarr Lane Farm, all in the parish of Symonds bury.

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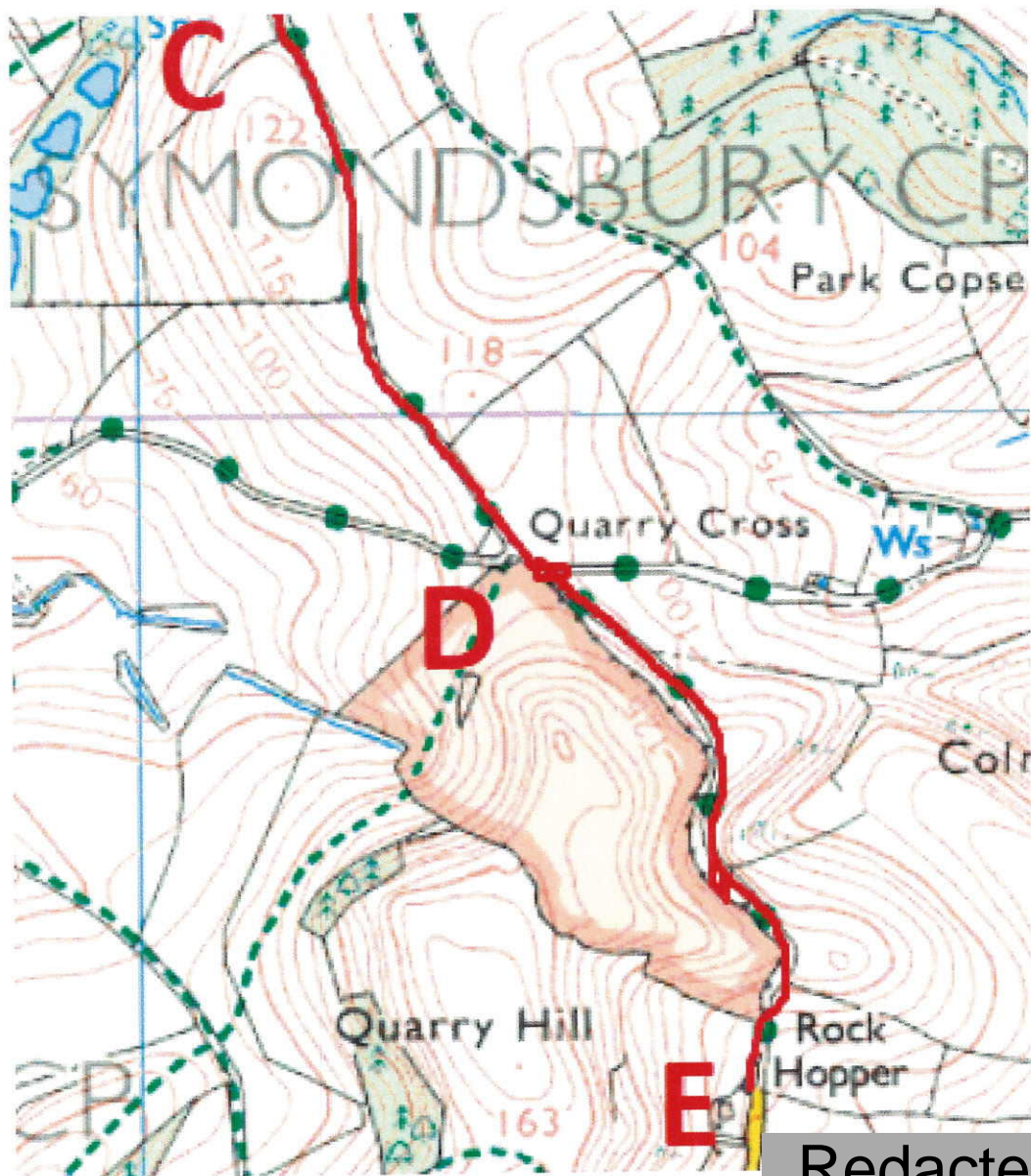
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
