I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route, known as Moorway Lane, starting from Point A (at approximately ST 6100 1946) on the county road a short distance north of Rosedown Farm, and extending eastwards to Point B (at approximately 6164 1992) at the junction with Middle Field Lane, and then extending and zig-zagging eastward to Point C (at approximately ST6263 2002) on the county road near Higher Sandford, all in the parish of Sandford Orcas.
