I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route, known as Barrows Lane, extending from Point A (at approximately ST 5811 2000) on the public road between Hinton Cross and Hummer Farm, zigzagging south-eastwards to Point B (at approximately ST 5862 1935) on the public road by Anchor Farm, all in the Parish of Trent, to be shown as Byway Open to All Traffic.
