I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route known as Barrows Lane, starting from Point A (at approximately ST 5170 0548), on the main road in Corscombe village, and extending southwest to Point B (at approximately ST 5146 0513) the northern end of definitive bridleway W 26/40, then westwards to Point C (at approximately ST 5126 0511), on the public road, Hackney, opposite the eastern end of definitive bridleway W 26/41 in the parish of Corscombe.
