I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a bridleway along the route, part of which is known as Mower Lane starting from Point A (at approximately ST 8320 1614) on Fishey Lane in West Orchard and extending south westwards through Point B (at approximately ST 8293 1577) and south-eastwards to Point C (at approximately ST 8305 1561) the junction with Mower Lane in the Parish of West Orchard and then eastwards along Mower Lane into East Orchard to Point D (at approximately ST 8408 1605) at the junction with the county road north of West Farm in East Orchard.
