I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route known as Horsington Lane, starting from Point B (at approximately ST 8164 3004), on the county boundary with Mere, Wiltshire, and extending southwards to Point C (at approximately ST 8171 2973), and upgrading to a Byway Open to All Traffic the section of the public footpath N 64/12 between Point C and Point D (at approximately ST 8167 2967), at the junction with the public road in Milton on Stour near Forest Side Farm, all in the parish of Gillingham.
