I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route, starting from Point A (at approximately SY 4625 9834) at the end of the public road near Patley Wood Farm, and extending south south-eastwards past Point B (at approximately SY 4637 9820) where definitive bridleway W 36/40 meets the route, and Point C (at approximately SY 4640 9784) where definitive bridleway W 36/37 joins the route, to Point D (at approximately SY 4661 9709) on the public road near Purcombe Farm House, all in the parish of Netherbury.
