I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic from Point A (at approximately SU 0834 1232) on Hare Lane, southwards to Point B (at approximately SU 0833 1229) and then westwards around the Hare Lane Farm buildings to Point C (at approximately SU 0824 1229). And to upgrade to a Byway Open to All Traffic the footpath which runs from Point C (at approximately SU 0824 1229) south westwards along Purbeck Lane to Point D (at approximately SU 0788 1177) at the junction with the ORPA routes on the parish boundary with Edmondsham. The application route is in the parish of Cranborne.
