I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding A Byway Open to All Traffic byway along the route starting from Point A (at approximately ST 6114 0308) at the corner in the county road at the junction with definitive bridleway S 42/24, extending north eastwards along the parish boundary between Frome St. Quintin and Sydling St. Nicholas and then between Batcombe and Sydling St. Nicholas to Point B (at approximately ST 6152 0328) to the bend in the county road near the junction with Stile Way. This application route is in the parishes of Frome St. Quintin and Batcombe.
