I, Sarah Bucks of Bryants Farm, Dowlish Wake, Ilminster, Somerset TA19 0NX, for and on behalf of the British Horse Society, hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a Byway Open to All Traffic along the route known as Langdon Lane, starting from Point A (at approximately SY 4113 9340) on the public road, Muddyford Road, near the A37 eastwards and southwards to Point C (at approximately SY 4155 9245) at the eastern end of public footpath W 10/23, then eastwards along Pettycrate Lane for a short distance to Point D (at approximately SY 4168 9244), then south-eastwards to Point F (at approximately SY 4199 9216) at the junction with the public road, Sea Hill Lane, by Sea Hill House in the Parish of Chideock.
